You will probably need the Web or other references to solve some of these puzzles. That’s fine.

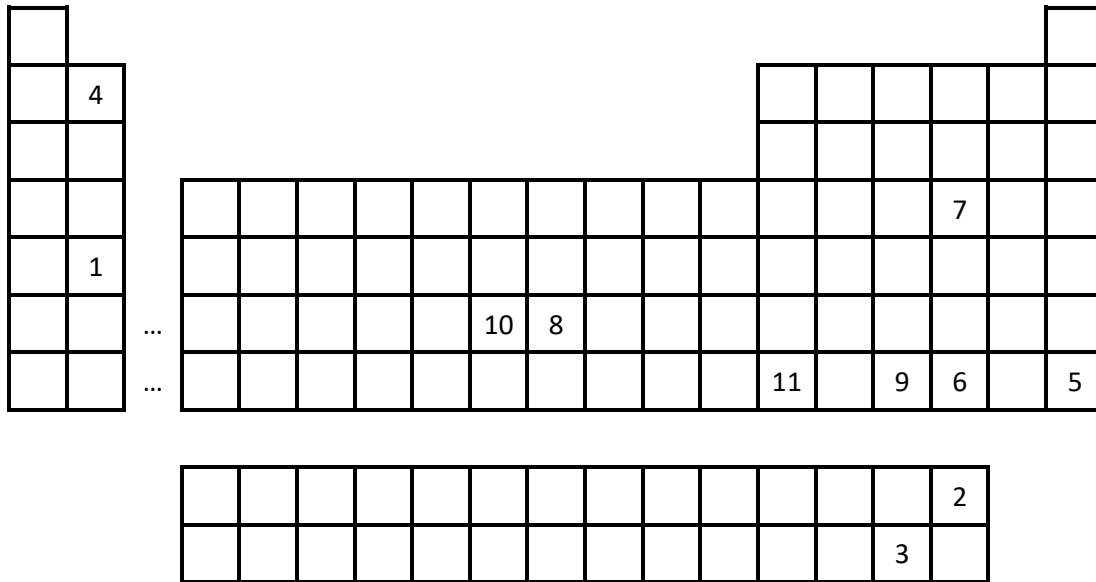

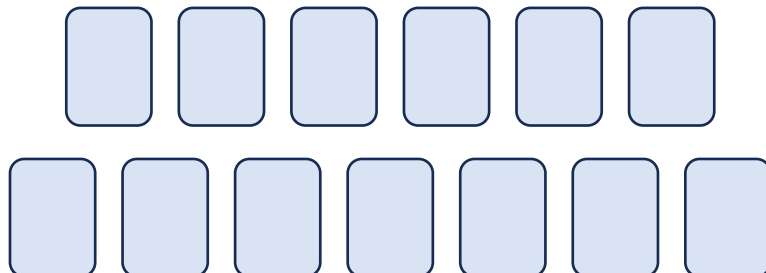

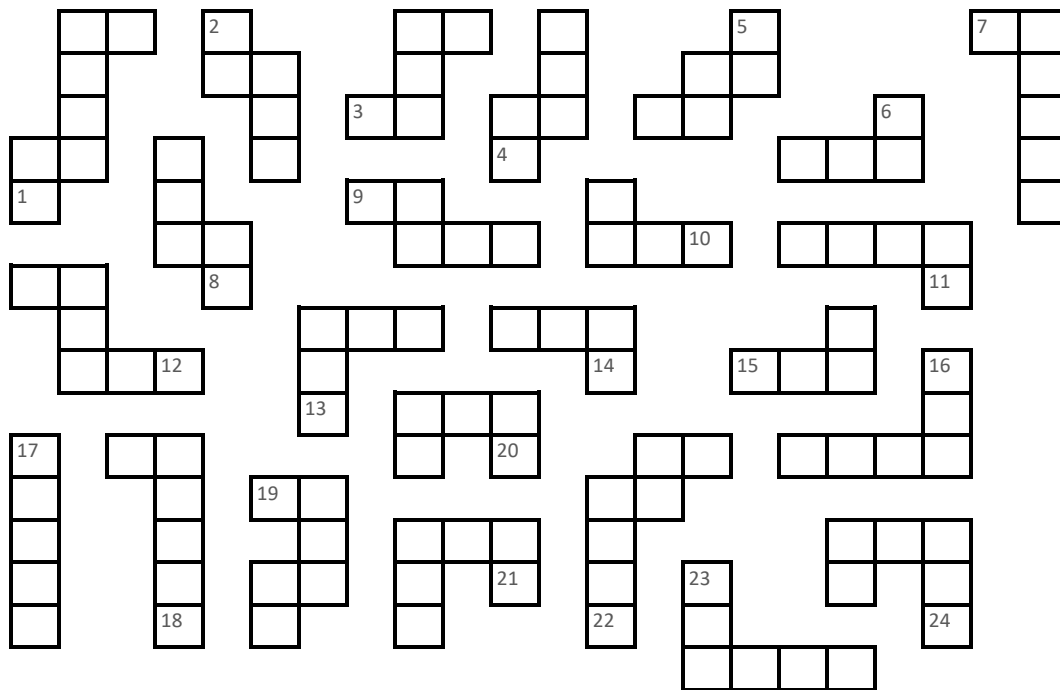

You will need to figure out how to place the "pieces" in the grid so that the letters match with the answers to the "rows" clues. Pieces do not need to be rotated, nor will they overlap.

In the completed puzzle each letter will be used twice.
